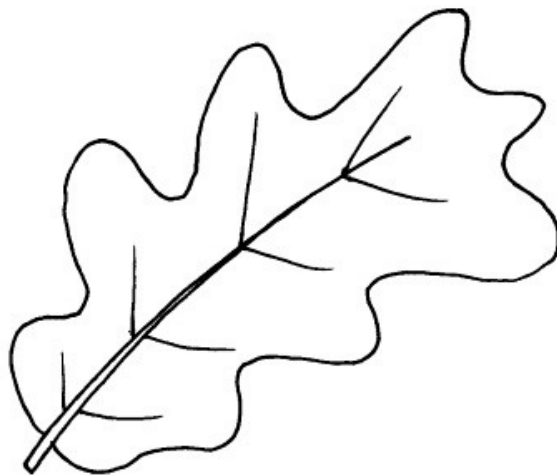

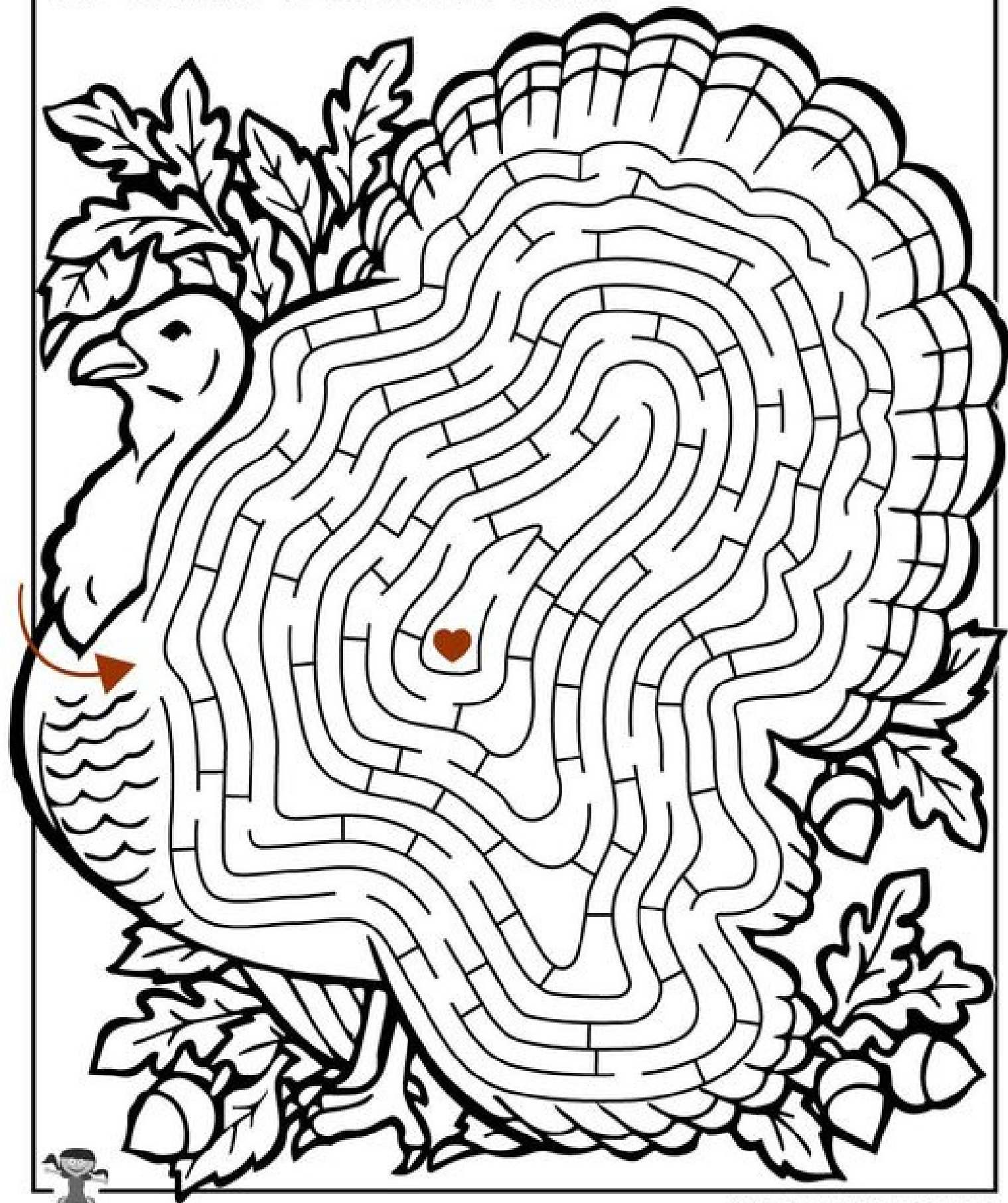

Pumpkin Cheeseball Recipe

Ingredients

- 2 (8 ounces) packages cream cheese, softened
- 1 tsp onion powder
- 1 tb dried chives
- 2 tsp paprika
- ½ tsp ground red pepper
- 8 ounces sharp cheddar cheese, finely shredded
- 1 broccoli stalk

Instructions

1. Combine cream cheese, onion powder, chives, paprika, and red pepper until well blended. Stir in shredded cheddar cheese until well combined. Cover and refrigerate up to 2 hours or until mixture is firm enough to shape.
2. Shape mixture into a ball. Smooth the entire surface with a spoon or spatula. Using your fingertips, create vertical grooves in the ball to resemble a pumpkin.
3. Remove florets from broccoli stalk and reserve for another use. Cut stalk to resemble a pumpkin stem and press in the top of the cheeseball. Serve with crackers, apples, or celery .

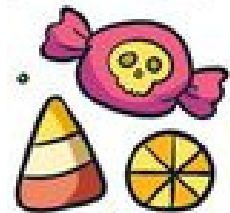
Notes

To make ahead, wrap cheeseball in plastic without stalk and store in the refrigerator up to 2 days. Just before serving, create grooves and attach stalk.

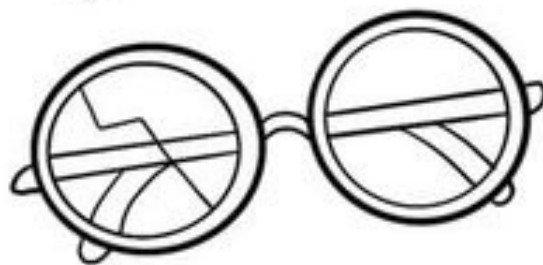
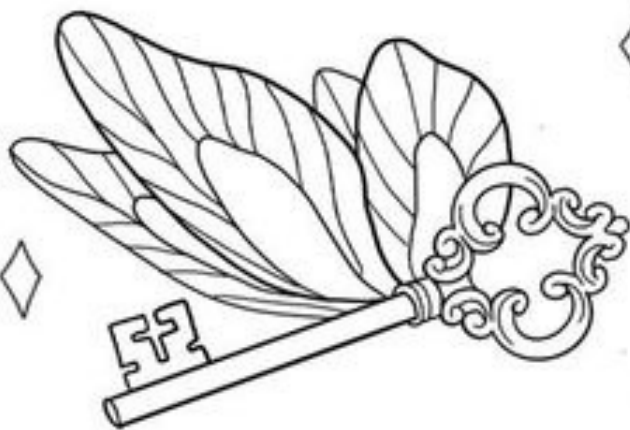

Ingredients

- 1 18x18 inch Piece of flannel fabric
- 1 roll of Toilet Paper Mega size is best
- 1 stick
- 1 9 inch piece of Green Ribbon

Instructions

1. Lay out your fabric square. Place a roll of TP in the center.
2. UNROLL the toilet paper 8-10 times. Then ROLL it back up, twisting and scrunching the toilet paper as you do so. This give you a rounder pumpkin shape.
3. Grab one corner of the fabric and tuck it inside the toilet paper roll, using a pencil to push it down.
4. Continue with the other three corners, gathering up the fabric as you stuff each corner into the center of the toilet paper roll.
5. Tie a ribbon around a twig and stuff it in the center of the pumpkin for a stem.
