Print out the activity and color it in. Cut out pieces along the dotted line. Fold pieces along the fold lines.



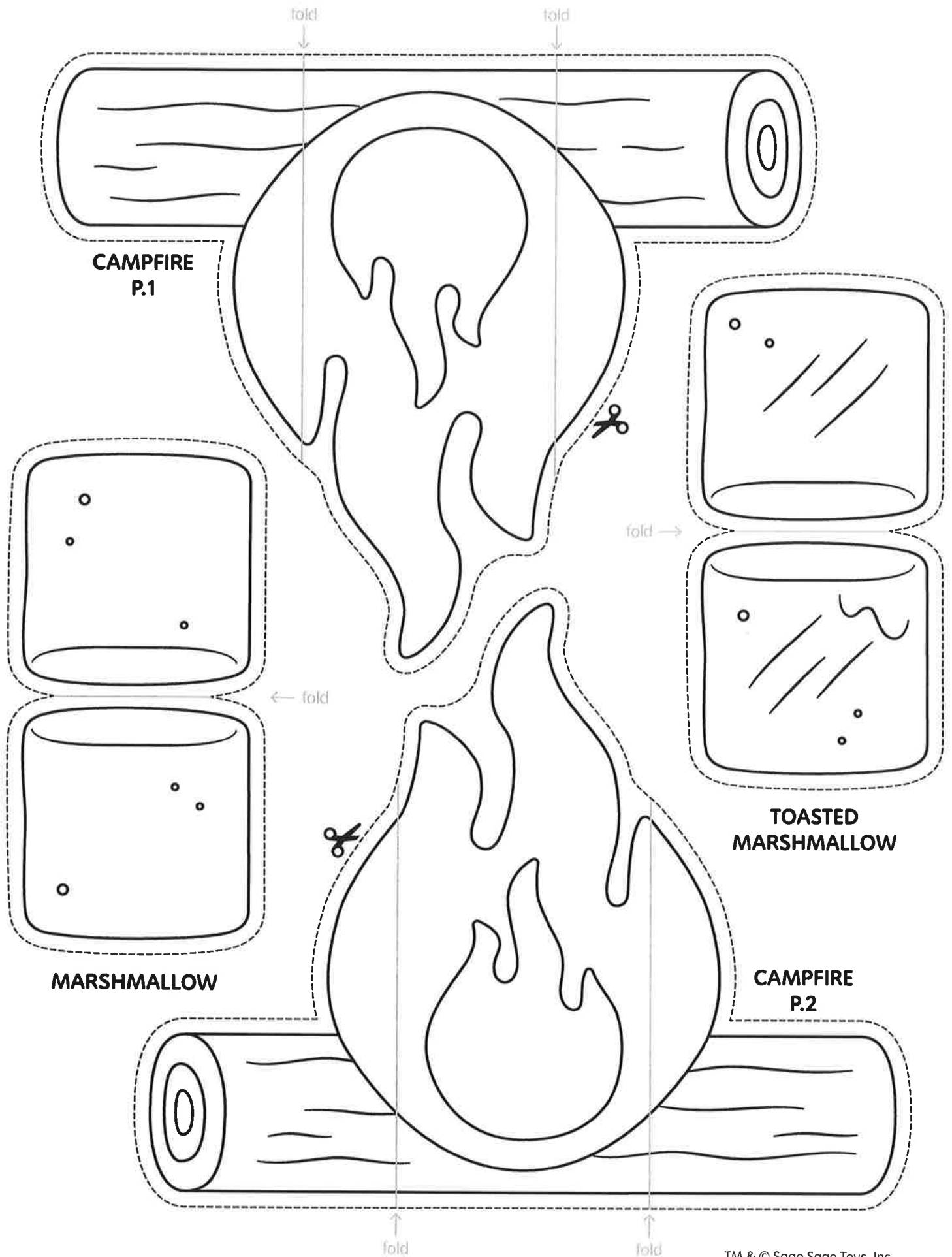
2. Assemble and glue

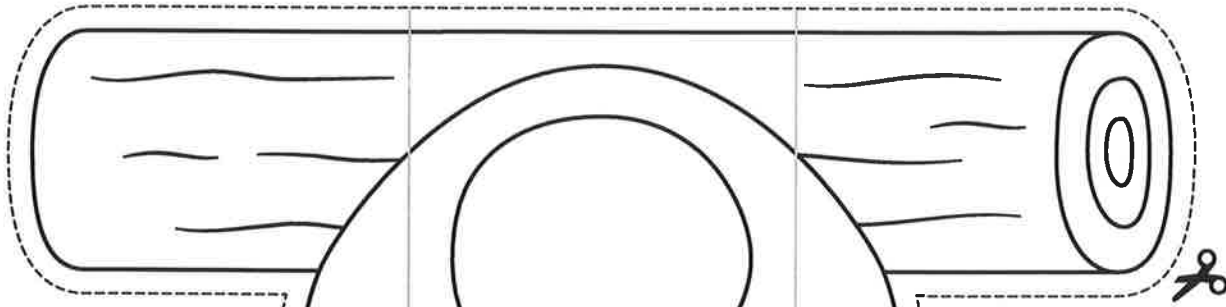
Glue the campfire pieces together and glue the inside of the marshmallows over the stick, ensuring it can be removed.



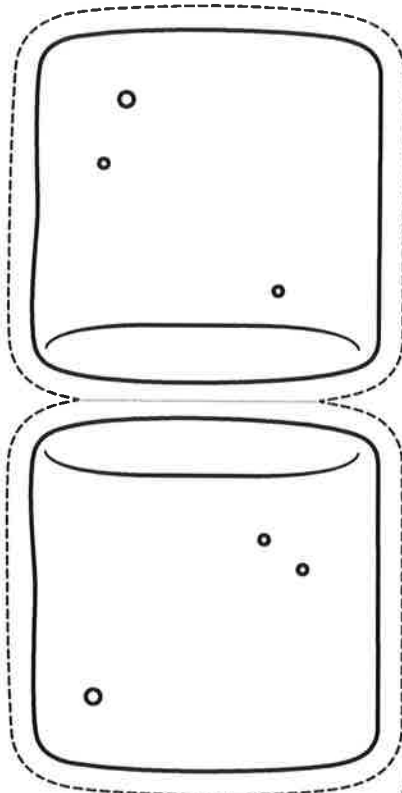
3. Light the "fire"

Place the battery-operated flameless tealight in the center of the campfire, turn off the lights and make s'mores!

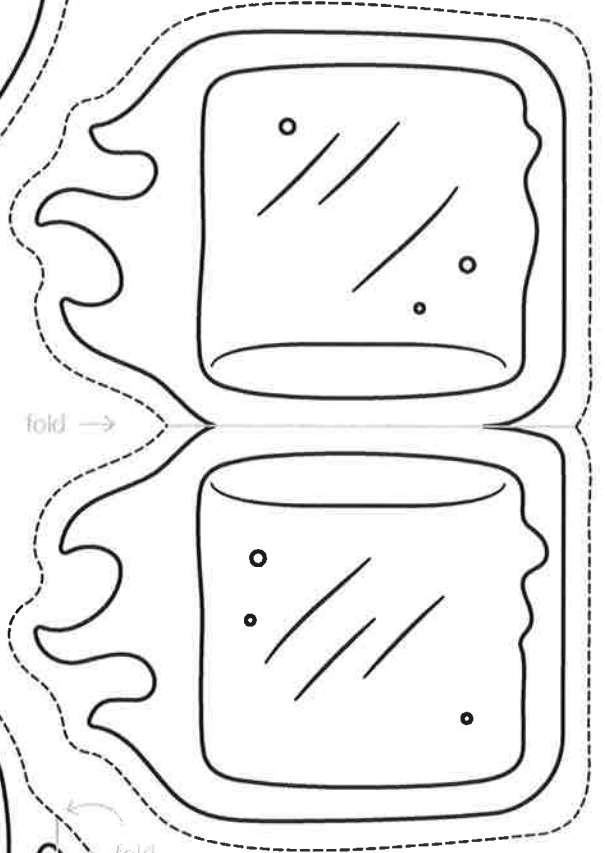




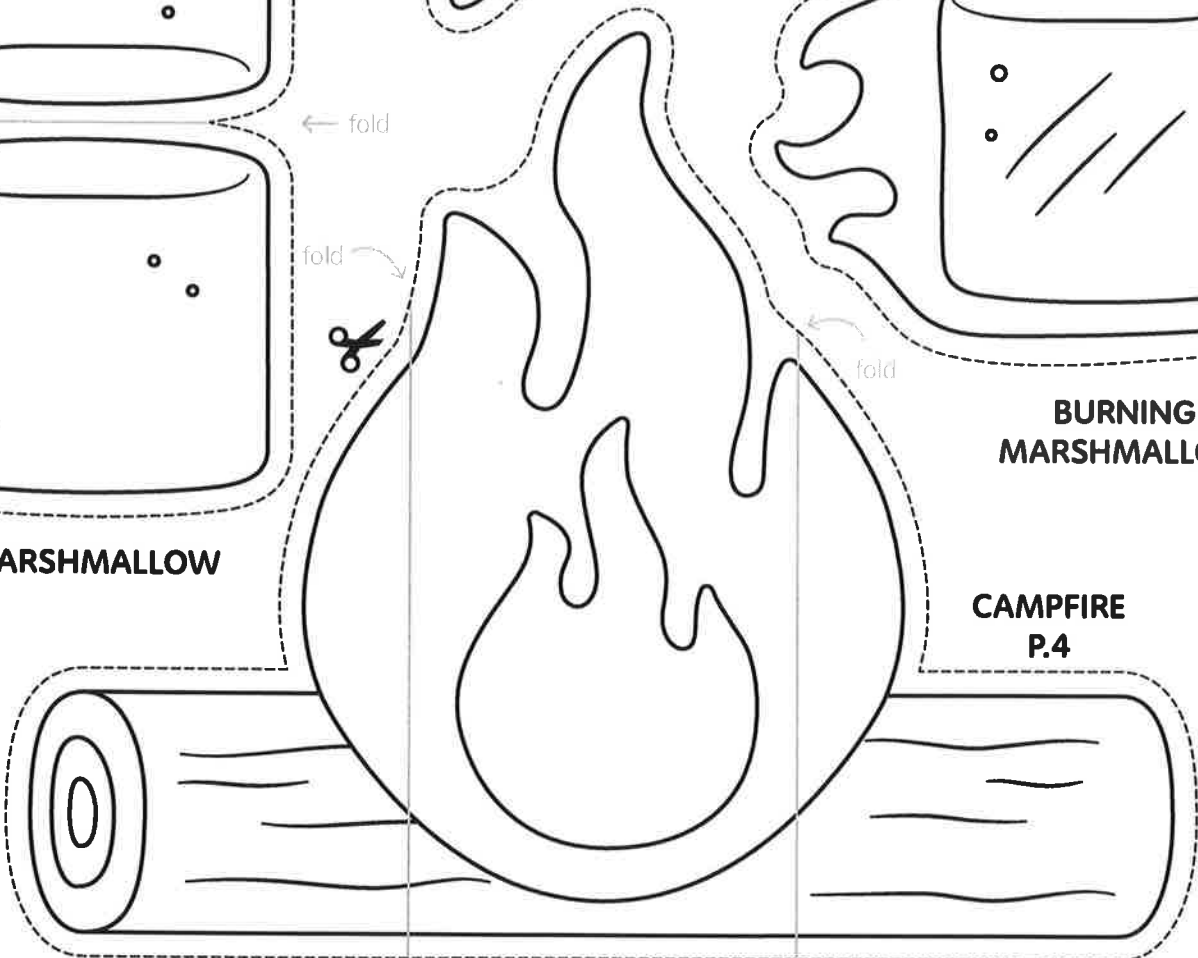
