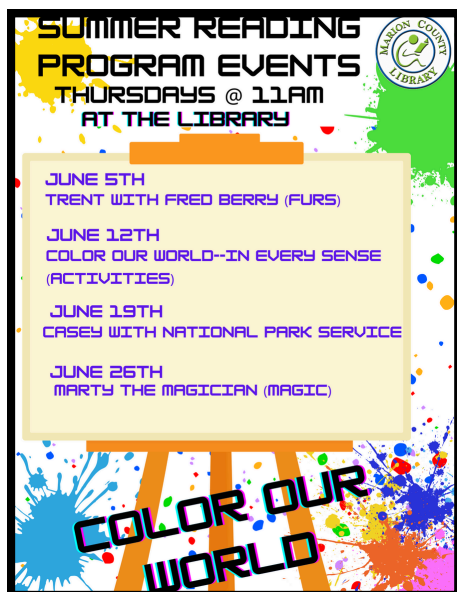

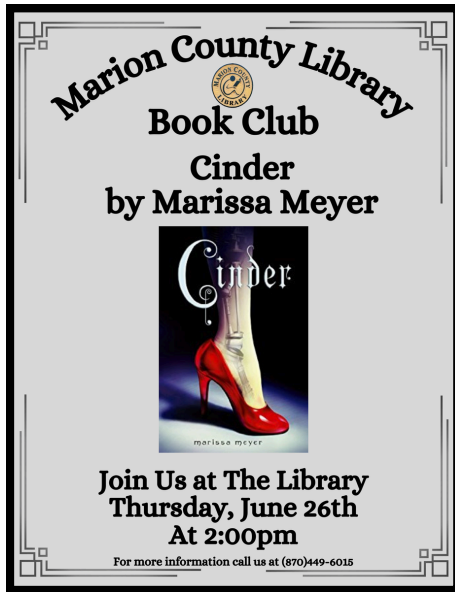

Join Our Book Club

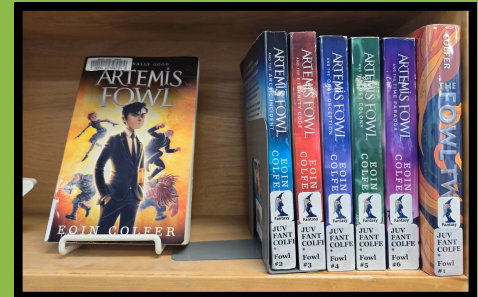
June's Book Club book will be Cinder by Marissa Meyer!

We welcome everyone aged 12 and up - gaming experience is not required.

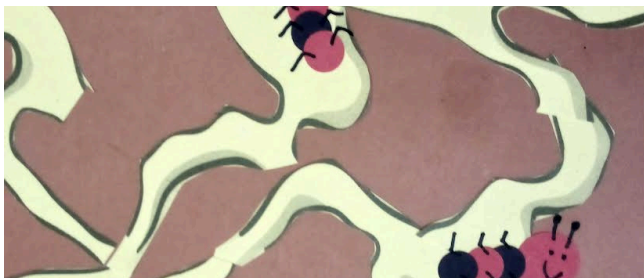
Kids and Teens are welcome to come in after school, and join in the fun!

Come Craft With Us!

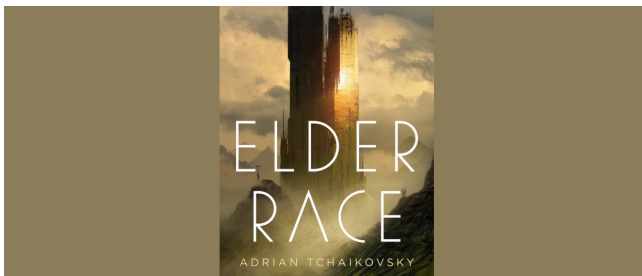
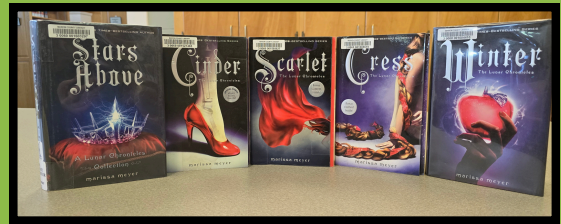

We welcome everyone aged 12 and up - crafting experience is not required. Some supplies can be provided.

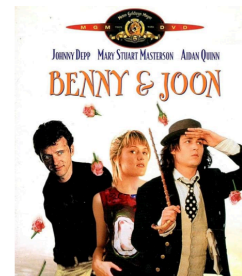
Teen Series Highlight
