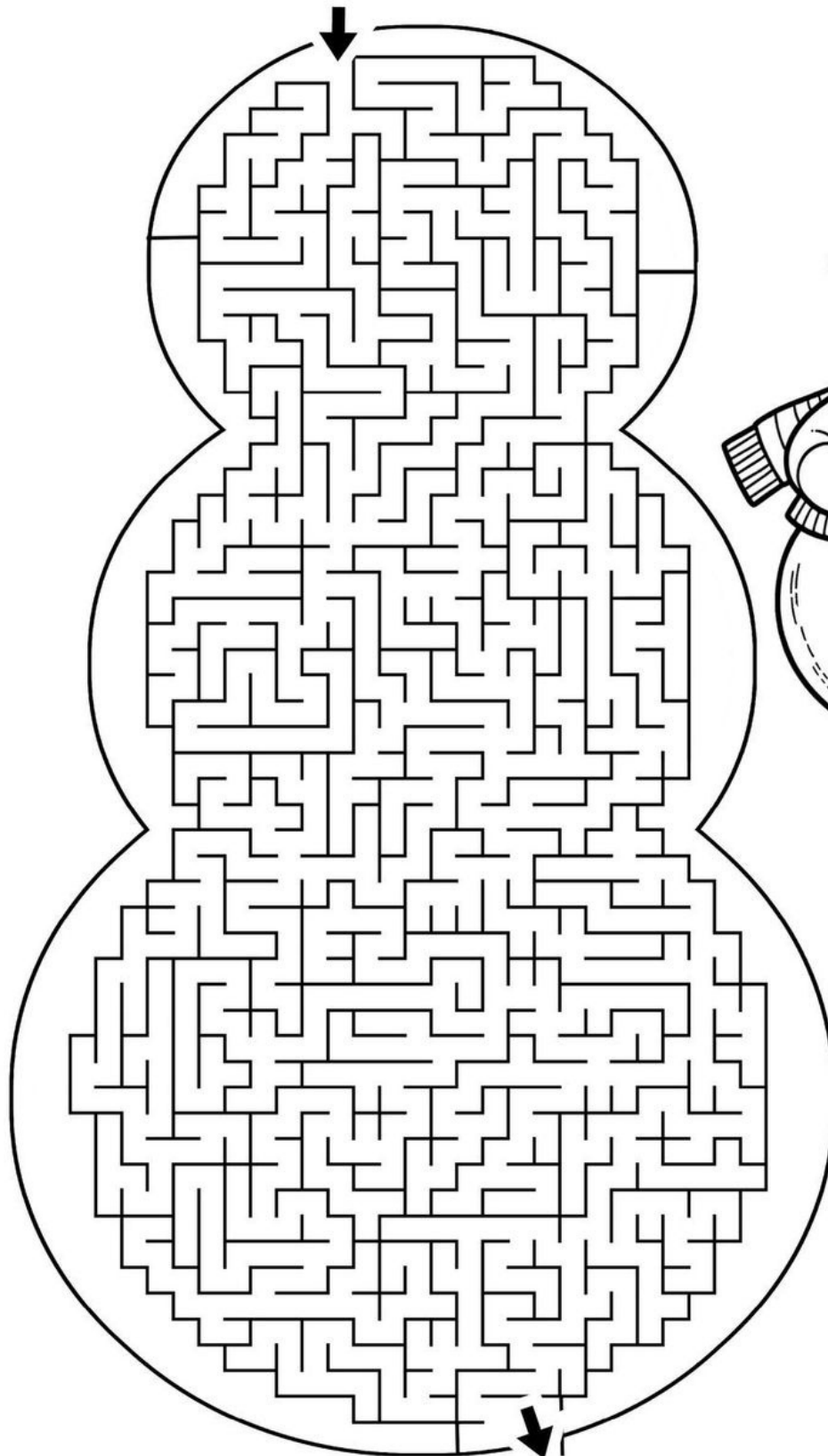

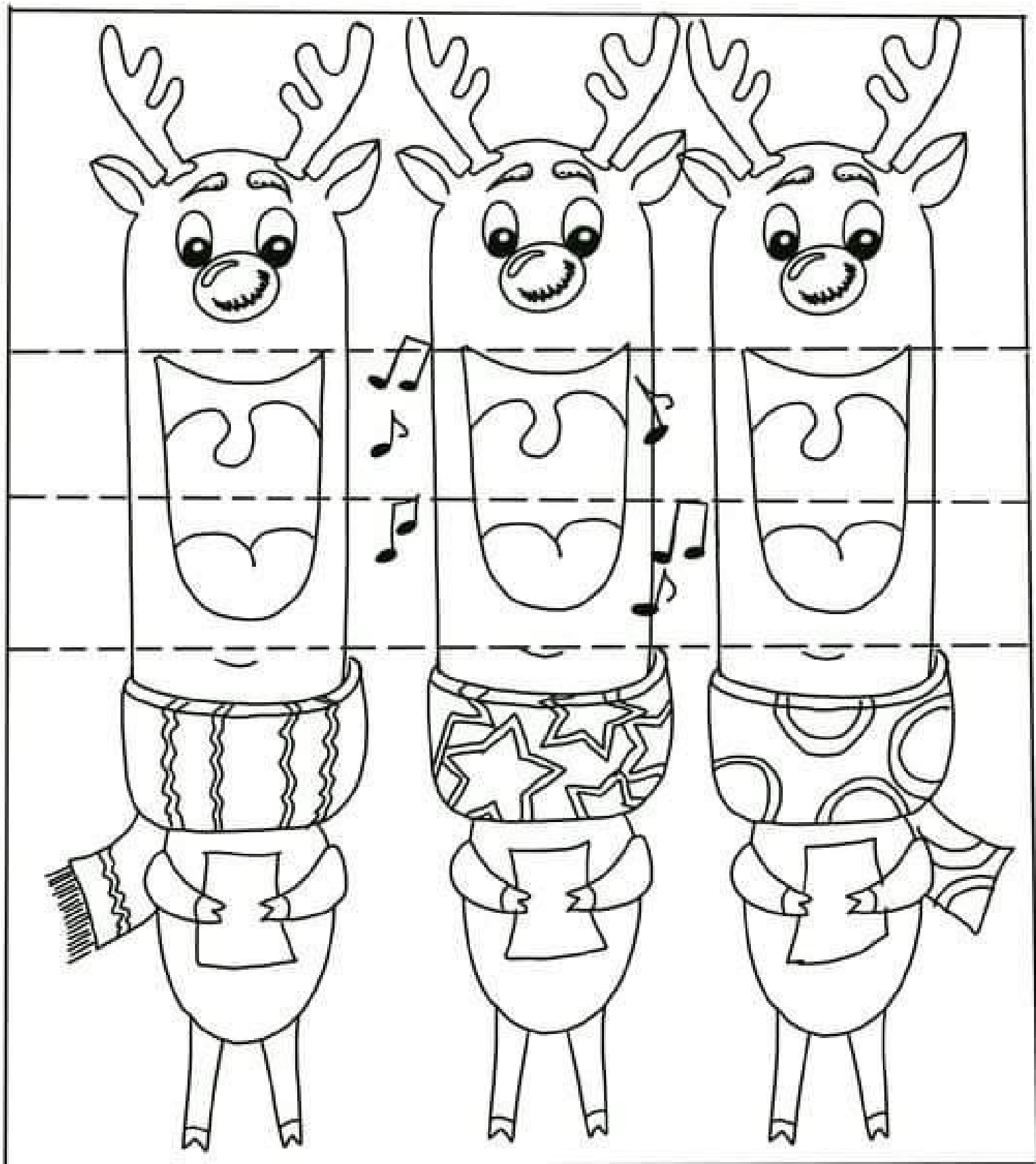

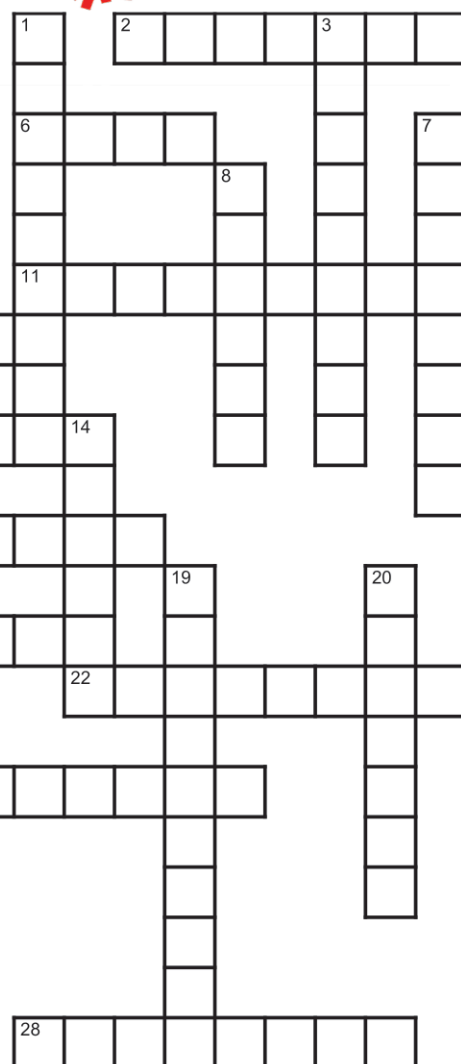

Snowflake Pretzels Recipe (No Bake)

These snowflake pretzels are a fun no bake treat perfect for winter, Christmas, and more! With salty, crunchy pretzels and white chocolate, they're a delicious sweet and savory bite!

Ingredients

- 48 mini pretzel twists (or 4 per snowflake)
- 1 cup white chocolate chips
- 3 Tbsp winter sprinkles - white, silver, or blue (amount approximate)

Instructions

1. **Add your white chocolate chips to a microwave safe bowl. Line a baking tray (or similar) with parchment, wax paper, or a silicone baking mat**
1 cup white chocolate chips
2. **Melt the chocolate chips by cooking on high for 30 seconds. Stir, then continue to heat in 30-second increments, stirring after each, until melted and smooth.** *If you use candy melts, follow the package directions instead, as they may differ*
3. **Transfer the melted chocolate to a candy piping bag (or a Ziploc) and cut off the tip**
4. **Make a circle of chocolate about 1" wide, then 4 pretzels to the chocolate, bottoms facing each other.** *Repeat until all pretzels are used*
48 mini pretzel twists
5. **Now, pipe a plus sign, and then a slightly smaller X across the pretzels to make a snowflake design.** *You can add a little rounded dollop of chocolate at the end of each strip if you like.* **While the chocolate is still soft, add on sprinkles and gently press down so they stick**
3 Tbsp winter sprinkles - white, silver, or blue
6. **Once decorated, let the snowflakes sit until they harden.** *Speed this process up by sticking them in the fridge or freezer for 15-20 minutes*
7. **Enjoy immediately, or store in a cool, dry place for up to 1 week**
