DIRECTIONS: Use a different colored pencil or pen to trace the path from the hat to its matching mitten.





To make polar bear graham crackers, spread white icing on a graham cracker, add marshmallow ears at the top corners, and place a marshmallow or brown mini M&M for the nose. Finish by adding two candy eyeballs above the nose to create a cute, edible polar bear treat. [🔗](#)

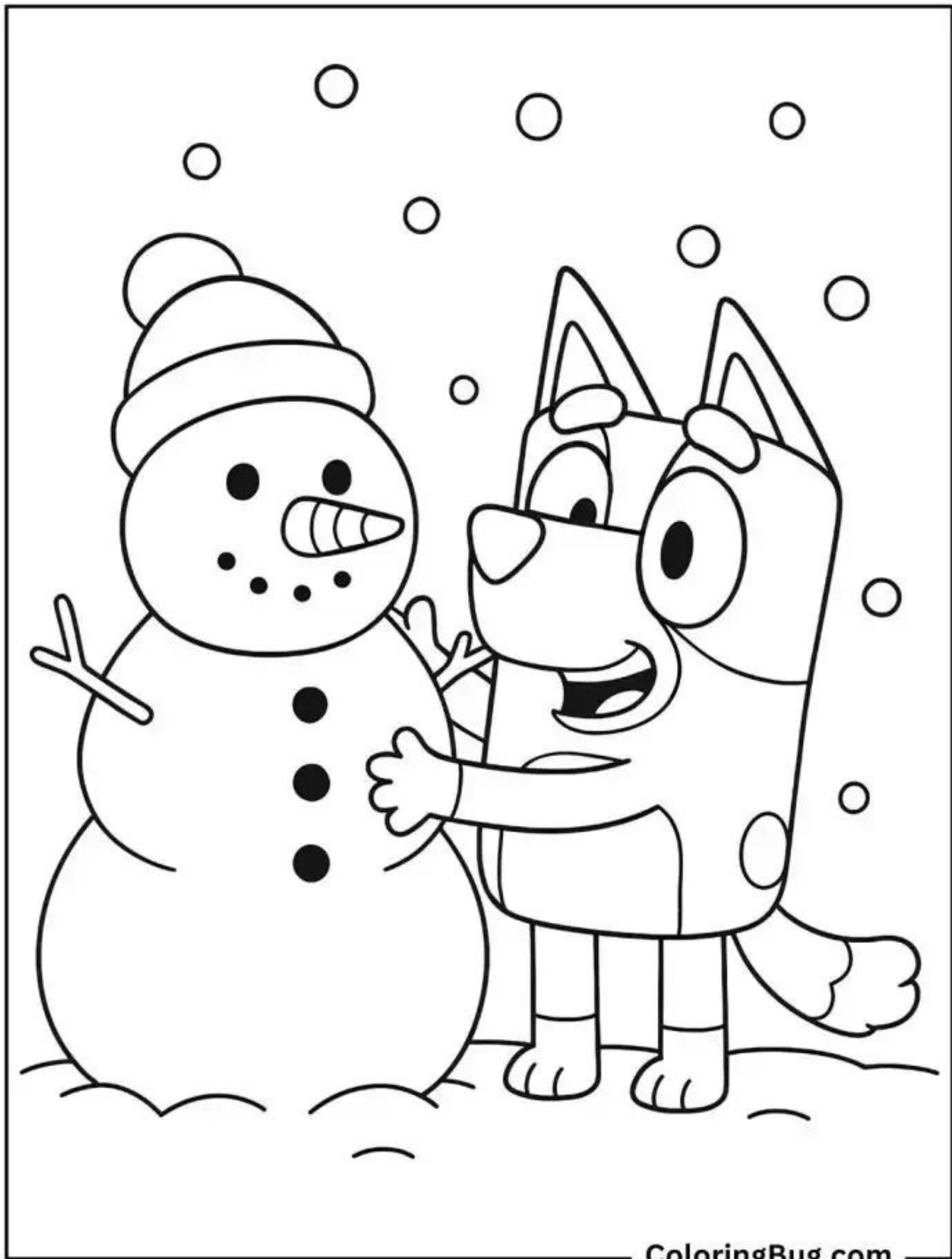
Ingredients

- Graham crackers, halved
- White vanilla icing or white chocolate
- Mini marshmallows
- Candy eyeball sprinkles
- Brown mini M&Ms (optional, for the nose)

Instructions

1. Spread a layer of white icing or melted white chocolate on a graham cracker half to serve as the base and "fur".
2. Use the icing or chocolate to stick two mini marshmallows at the top corners of the cracker to create ears.
3. Place a marshmallow or a brown mini M&M in the center of the lower half of the cracker for the nose.
4. Position two candy eyeball sprinkles above the nose.
